Eligibility for Scottish Qualification

R4.5.3 A competitor selected to represent Scotland must be either:

- a) a native of Scotland **or**
- b) a person with a Scottish mother or father **or**
- c) satisfy either of the following residential criteria:
 - i) for the Commonwealth Games –
In line with current Commonwealth Games Federation Regulations or Guidelines
(see information guide for details)
 - ii) for all other meets –
a person who has been resident in Scotland for a minimum of six months in the 12 months prior to the first day of competition

1. Proof of Eligibility for Scottish non-residential status is required. Please forward a *copy* of the birth certificate along with the completed Non-Residential form to Scottish Swimming.
2. Being an Anglo/Non-Residential Scot allows members to qualify for Scottish National Events on qualification and 'consideration' times.
3. Being an Anglo/Non-Residential Scot entitles the non-residential member to compete at Scottish National events and claim Scottish titles and records however the member would not be able to claim English/Welsh National titles or records.
4. National Open Events can be entered by all members representing their respective countries and claim titles and records.
