

The Scottish Open Water Swimming Relay Grand Prix Series comprises mixed relay events (two male swimmers and two female) at each District Championships and at the Scottish Championships. These relays can be standard relays, pursuit relays, chain relays or similar, as determined by the rules of the individual relevant qualifying event. Relay teams can be changed between qualifying events.

- The club must be a club or composite club registered with Scottish Swimming.
- Competing swimmers must be registered with Scottish Swimming as members of the club or composite on the date of the swim (first or second club).
- Points are not transferrable. The relay team must be competing for the named club or composite on the day. Teams competing for individual clubs which are part of a composite cannot retrospectively add their points to the composite's total.

- Where more than one relay team from a club gains points, the points for the club will be cumulative.
- In the event of a tie on points, the higher placing will be given to the club with the greater number of total points from the Scottish Championship event.
- If any of the events are cancelled for whatever reason, no points will be awarded.
