- Approval new rules in Dec 2018
- No new rules issued until Feb 2019
- FINA WATER POLO RULES 2019–2021

- Varying degrees of take up to date
- Local constraints
- We will introduce them from 1<sup>st</sup> July which in effect means competitions for 2019-20 season

## 2. SWP Disciplinary Code

- This is standard across water polo across Great Britain
- Focus on the sanctions to be applied to offences reported by the referees
- All offences of Misconduct, Brutality or Red Card of a Coach must be reported by the match referee using the Reportable Offences Form
- Automatic Sanctions
  - Misconduct offences will receive an automatic sanction of 1 game.
  - Brutality offences will receive an automatic sanction of 2 games.
  - Red Card offences will receive an automatic sanction of 1 game.
  - Red Card offences involving brutality will receive an automatic sanction of 2 games.
- There is no right of appeal against an Automatic Sanction
- Publish document on web site





## 2. SWP Disciplinary Code

- There is no recourse for coaches or team officials to complain about the performance of referee or delegate unless breaching FINA\LEN\BS\SS rules
- Referee Evaluation this opportunity is on every match sheet – HOWEVER, we need change in our approach and have a referees coordinator to make this work
- There is no recourse for spectators to complain about the activities in a match or outside unless breaching FINA\LEN\BS\SS rules








## SNL - Issues







## SNL - Issues

#### Mainly focused on age group leagues

- 1. Last minute organisation
- 2. Unsure who will enter
- 3. Too many game cancelled particularly U19, Men & Women
- 4. U16 short games (& long travel times)
- 5. No appointment of referees (=> lack of support for younger referees)
- 6. Wasted pool time
- 7. Costs lot more pool time being used for SNL, only for junior events



## **SNL** - Solutions

- 1. Last minute organisation
  - Allocate sessions now for first half of the season 2019-20
- 2. Unsure who will enter
  - Assume those who entered "short season" will follow on, so make plans based upon this
- 3. Too many game cancelled
  - Early publication of dates to allow clubs to plan
  - Encourage teams to use and promote League Republic
  - Use Saturday & Sunday sessions for Leagues (removing Friday night travelling issue)
- 4. No appointment of referees (=> lack of support for younger referees)
  - With early scheduling take opportunity to appoint referees
- 5. Wasted pool time
  - As result of the above, this should reduce
- 6. Costs
  - Revise costs
  - Continue to fine non attendees



## SNL - Other considerations

- 1. Last minute organisation
  - We cannot be 100% sure of pool availability so will have some unallocated session that can be used to flex requirements
- Unsure who will enter
  - If expected teams do not enter then re-arrange their games
- 3. Home & Away matches
